"It was silly," Zion said. "It had a guy in a coffin. It talked about so many things, it was confusing."



As for McDonald's, the reviews were mixed on the "Coaching Lolo Jones" advertisement. The fast-food chain was praised for the feel good message it conveyed but wasn't clear in what it were promoting.

"So what I'm focusing on French fries and I'm showing a guy carrying a Coca Cola giving tips to an Olympic athlete," Zion said. "It'll make him or her feel better about themselves because they're already consuming McDonald's."
